September through December.

September 2021 was first month when the team could conduct the ministry in person. The ministry nature in this period is in person meeting. It is clear to see how the effectiveness of ministry directly related to the personal relationship. The Centurions team used this effectiveness. The work with Cadets, Officers, Counsels and mission trips expanded the team further, providing platform for more ministry growth.



Cadets Team:

The September started with Leadership seminar hosted over 80 cadets and 21 decided to come to the follow up Evangelistic event. These cadets knew to what type of event they are coming. The team witnessed 18 cadets came to Christ and join the ministry follow up groups.



As the follow up to the outreach team conducted an Honors project. It is gear to train believers in how to share their faith through 4 spiritual laws. This is first time after two years the team could conduct in person train while before most effort was online. Over 25 cadets attended the event to expand their faith and able to share their joy of journey with personal relationship with Christ. The training designed to prepare to the Christmas outreach events. Staff members taught Biblical principles of the Pre-marriage and Dating so that cadets understood borders between men and women. It helps them to set the proper priorities in their lives and deal with unique special relationship with the Biblical manner. We are encouraged to see these cadets are very mobilized and happy to talk about their faith to fellow cadets now.



Mission trip to country:

The in-person ministry gave opportunity to conduct in country trips and opened new doors for the ministry. The leadership of Leaders Strategy of Mongolia a division of MCCC conducted research trip to the Northern area: cities of Darkhan and Erdenet the regional hub centers. The mission

We conducted Ethic by Lt.Col Ganhvleg, Leadership seminar by Bataa and Women's Values seminar by Gantuya and Undrakh. God raised nine groups in the provinces' centers, and we will continue training and develop them in 2022 to grow further.

Our psychologists' fellowship:

Leadership of Military and Police Departments face challenge of emotional and mental wellbeing of the personnel. The high number of divorce rate, emotional downs, even suicide cases reveal the internal issues of the personnel. For many years Police Department have formed Psychologist core team to address this issue and the team is slowing bringing positive outcomes. “Centurions” formed Psychologist’s fellowship to assist the professionals with fellowship and professional care. The team launched five months ongoing training series over 50 Police psychologists in personal and online format. They meet once a week and learn from the Gerelmaa, who graduated in USA with master’s in clinical psychology. Please keep for this fellowship and the training event. If this event succeeds the team will be able to enter to the Border Troop and Army psychologists. This is one the vital areas of ministry. They are the key people for the outreaches.



Christmas:



Grand conclusion of the year were series of ministry outreach events during Christmas time. Cadets team had 4 outreach programs with over 60 new cadets attended and 40 received Christ. Now they are in the process of follow up. Praise the Lord! The Christmas event for officers' team was more reconnecting disciples to ministry after long time of none-person period. 20 Officers attended with their spouses and children giving the ministry expansion opportunity in the areas of marriage and parenthood.
